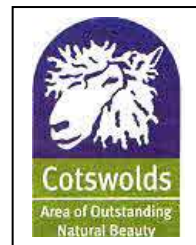


**LOCAL WALKS WITH THE

Along the Border – Thursday January 05 – Moderate

A hidden area of the Cotswolds on the Oxfordshire/Gloucestershire borders, with fine scenery and a gruesome story. Optional pub lunch at the end. 2.25 hours; 4.5 miles.

Start: 10.00 am Merrymouth Inn on A425 Burford to Stow Road. OS Map ref 231 185

You think today's teachers have problems? – Saturday January 07 – Moderate

Short walk, true story. The woeful tale of a string of teachers who couldn't handle the pressures of running a Gloucestershire village school in the mid 19th century. Pub lunch available. Suitable for teachers! 4hours; 5 miles.

Start: 10.00 am Hidcote Manor National Trust car park. OS Map ref 177 430

A Winter's Walk whilst Nature is Resting – Saturday 21 January - Moderate

Follow the Winchcombe Way towards the Salt Way and Little Farmcote. Good views but keep a weather watch as we return along the edge of Guiting Wood and Deadmanbury Gate. Please bring a packed lunch. 4 hours; 8 miles.

Start: 10.00 am Winchcombe Back Lane car park. OS Map ref 023 284.

PLEASE use appropriate footwear as some walks may be steep and muddy in places. MODERATE - includes some hills and rough ground. We welcome guide and hearing dogs but sorry, others are not allowed.

Walks are free although donations help to fund our conservation work and improvement projects.
