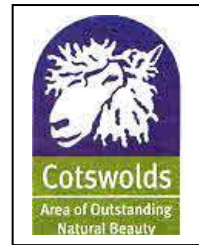


**LOCAL WALKS WITH THE
COTSWOLDS VOLUNTARY WARDENS
NOVEMBER 2011**



Perambulations at Power - 1 – Thursday November 03 – Moderate

First of three walks exploring the fascinating area around Guiting Power and the interrelation between its geography, flora, history and modern usage. Exact route to be determined by whim and weather. Lunch available after the walk. 2-3 hours; 4-6 miles.

Start: 10.00 am Guiting Power village hall car park (Trust the Motorist). OS Map ref 095 246

Around Barter's Hill – Saturday November 05 - Strenuous

Enjoy the undulating countryside of West Oxfordshire to the south of Chipping Norton. Please bring a packed lunch. 6 hours, 12 miles.

Start: 9.30 am Churchill Parish Church on B4450 in centre of village. OS Map ref 283 241

Round and Round the Gardens – Saturday November 05 - Moderate

A circular walk from Bourton, along the ridge to Blockley and round the Batsford estate to Moreton-in-Marsh for lunch (available at the Bell Inn). 6 hours, 10.5 miles.

Start: 10.00 am Roadside – side road above Bourton-on-the-Hill - near Tower View Farm. OS Map ref 170 325

A Walk to Yubberton – Thursday November 10 – Moderate

Through open countryside towards Ebrington with good views and a return via a railway crossing. Pub lunch available. 4 hours, 6 miles.

Start: 10.00 am at Chipping Campden Town Square. OS Map ref 151 391

Walking from Longborough - 2 – Thursday November 24 – Moderate

Second in series to celebrate Longborough's "Walkers are Welcome" status. Going southwards, including a circuit of villages and Stow-on-the-Wold. Pub lunch available. 5 hours, 9 miles.

Start: 10.00 am Cotswold Food Store car park, Longborough (on A424). OS Map ref 170 296

PLEASE use appropriate footwear as some walks may be steep and muddy in places. STRENUOUS – May be rough underfoot and ascents and descents may be steep. MODERATE - includes some hills and rough ground. Sorry, no dogs allowed except guide and hearing dogs.

Walks are free although donations help to fund our conservation work and improvement projects.
